GENERAL CONDITIONS/COMMENTS

- Crating is allowed but shade is limited, bring your own.
- Breakfast and lunch will be available for purchase from Lazy Dog Barbecue.
- All awards must be claimed at the Trial. None will be mailed.

ALL CANCELLATIONS of entries must be made *in writing* (email ok, secretary will send a confirmation receipt if email address is provided) to the Trial Secretary and received prior to the stated date and time of closing of entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify receipt of cancellation. Cancellations will be assessed a \$6 processing fee. Any refund checks will be mailed after the event.

Telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. BITCHES IN SEASON will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered that is in season on the Trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5.00, upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 8:00 AM on the day of the Trial.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient.
