Awards: Each dog passing the Tracking Dog test will receive a dark green rosette and a framed copy of their track.

The Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months old. With the entry form in the TD Test of a dog which has not passed a "Tracking Test," there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a "Tracking Test," that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. Entry forms without an accompanying judge's statement will not be accepted. Entries without a Tracking Dog (TD) title will be accepted first.

The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 10 Weimaraners. Bitches in season will be allowed to run in this test as allowed in American Kennel Club Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2.

There will be no actual scores for the TD Test, but dogs will be rated "Passed" or "Not passed" and TD certificate will be issued by AKC confirming all dogs rated "Passed."

Telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

**Entries in this TD test** will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held on Sunday September 14<sup>th</sup> 2003, 9:00pm at the home of the Test Secretary to determine which entries will participate in the test. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, will be similarly drawn and assigned a position on an alternate list. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the results of the draw. Entries will be acknowledged with a draw number and map and directions to the test site. There will be no drawing if the advertised limit is not reached. Results of the drawing should be posted on the SVWC website by Monday evening:

In the event that an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it will be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the Alternate List, which alternates shall participate. NO entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate.

**ALL CANCELLATIONS** of entries must be made *in writing* (email ok, secretary will send a confirmation receipt if email address is provided) to the Test Secretary and received prior to the stated date and time of closing of entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to verify receipt of cancellation.

Make check or money order payable in US Funds to SVWC. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

## **Directions to G-Bar Retrievers Ranch**

**From Sacramento:** Take I-5 south approximately 33 miles and exit at Hwy 12. Turn left (east) on Hwy 12 and go to the second traffic light (Thornton Rd.). Turn left on Thornton and travel north for approximately 0.8 miles. Turn right into the ranch entrance (posted private). Turn left just before the first house on the left and proceed to the clubhouse parking lot on the right. Do not leave the parking lot area until instructed to do so.

**From Tracy:** Take I-5 north approximately 28 miles and exit at Hwy 12. Turn right (east) on Hwy 12, the first traffic light is Thornton Rd. From Thornton Rd., follow the Sacramento directions above.

**From Vallejo:** Take I-80 east approximately 13 miles and exit onto Hwy 12 east. Follow Hwy 12 for 41 miles to I-5. After the I-5 underpass, the second light is Thornton Rd. From Thornton Rd., follow the Sacramento directions above.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth),
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
